2022/23 Funding update - Schools Block

- 2022/23 'soft' NFF remains
- 3.2% increase overall
- 2.8% increase per pupil
- Core factors to increase by 3%
- Min funding levels to increase
 - Primary £4,265
 - Secondary £5,525
- MFG +0.5% +2%
- 0.5% transfer allowable
- NFF Consultation



2022/23 Funding update – High Needs Block

- Total NHB increase 9.6%
- 8% increase per head of population
- LBH Indicative £3.9m increase
- SEND Review?



2022/23 Funding update – Central School Services Block

- Increase of 5.6% for ongoing responsibilities
- Decrease of 20% for historic commitments
- Net funding decrease of £71k

- Shared goal to manage high needs block sustainably





Consultation Process

- Schools Forum decided on what to consult
- Consultation period 4 weeks (Sep/Oct)
- Schools Forum meet 20th Oct to discuss feedback
- Decisions then made which inform 2022/23 budget setting
- Disapplication process
