STEP UP (SUPPORTED BY IMPERIAL HEALTH CHARITY)

Who for? Young people aged 16-25, not in employment education or training (NEET)

What do we do? Supported work placements, employability skills workshops and personalised support with all aspects of the recruitment process to help you find and sustain employment



PROJECT SEARCH (IN PARTNERSHIP WITH LONDON BOROUGH OF HILLINGDON AND ORCHARD HILL COLLEGE)

Who for? Young people aged 17-24 with an EHCP

What do we do? A one-year supported internship based at the Civic Centre in Uxbridge. You will complete three ten-week placements over the course of the year alongside an Employability Skills qualification



TRANSITION SUPPORT

Who for? Young people aged 14-25

What do we do? A series of eight 1:1 transition mentoring sessions catered to your current circumstances e.g. finishing secondary school or applying for university



ACCESS TO WORK: IN-WORK SUPPORT

Who for? Young people and adults in paid employment

What do we do? Provide job coaching and other forms of support through the DWP Access to Work programme
