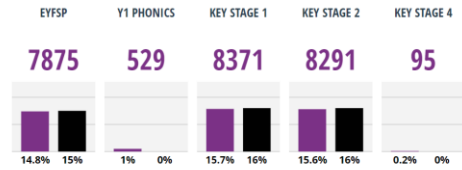
### ENROLMENT STATUS

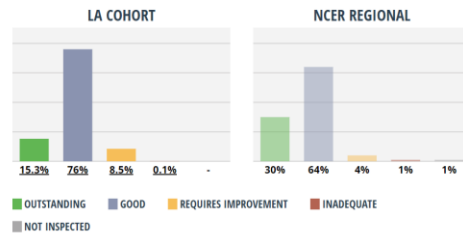
### SCHOOL TYPE

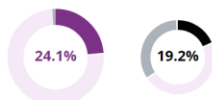

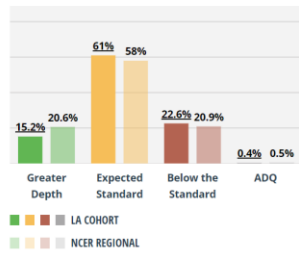
KS2: READING SCALED SCORE



In your LA for children in Key Stage 3/4, **25.1%** (2,579) achieved the higher standard in Reading, **5.7% lower than** the regional value. **49.0%** (5,062) of children in Key Stage 3/4 achieved the expected standard in Reading, **2.4% greater than** the regional value.

**22.1%** (2,269) of Key Stage 3/4 children in your LA did not achieve the expected standard in Reading, this is **3.3% greater than** the regional figure of **18.8%**. Additionally, **3.5%** (356) of Key Stage 3/4 children received no scaled score in Reading.

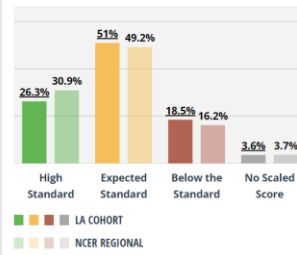

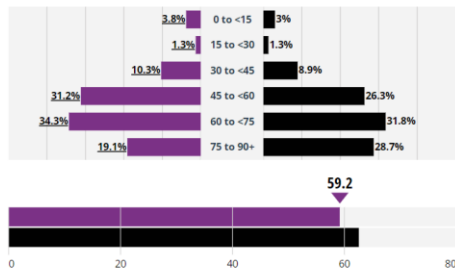

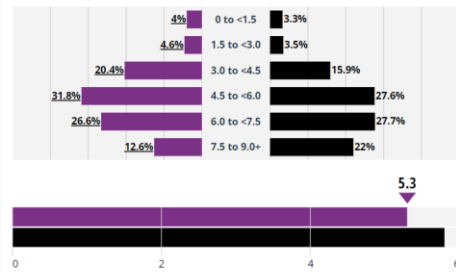
KS4: ATTAINMENT 8

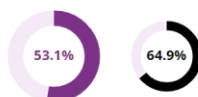

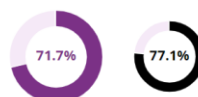
