EMERGING TALENT PROGRAMMES AT MACE

APPRENTICESHIPS

- School and college leavers
- Four years (plus an extra year of study if degree-level)
- Starts early September
- Level 3 to Level 6 (degree-level) academic qualification
- Professional membership with industry bodies, and support in obtaining a professional qualification (dependent on your role)

Programme requirements:

- Five GCSEs grade 4/C or above including Maths and English (or equivalent qualifications)
- 96 UCAS points (some programmes may require a higher number of UCAS points depending on the role you're applying for)
- Additional requirements may vary depending on the role you are applying for for some roles, you may need GCSEs or A Levels in a particular subject area.


