

Pre-Apprenticeship: Engineering Industries Automotive & Aerospace

Introduction

This online programme has been designed to support young people into engineering apprenticeships in the following industries: Automotive and Aerospace. This is with a guaranteed interview for those that meet the eligibility criteria and complete our boot-camp.

Eligibility

- 16 - 24 year olds
- NEET
- Right to live and work in the UK (Valid UK passport or birth certificate, official proof of address in the last 3 months and National Insurance number required)

Entry Requirements

Apprenticeship Level	Required Qualification
Level 2	Generally, 3 or more GCSEs at Grade 3 / D or above, particularly in Maths, English and Science. However, previous qualifications for some Level 2 apprenticeships are not necessary, but are favourable.
Level 3	The successful candidate will hold a minimum of 3 GCSEs, or equivalent, at a pass grade (C/4) or above. These GCSEs will include maths, English language and preferably a science/ engineering related subject.
Level 4	A Levels / BTEC Level 3 passes in relevant subjects.
