Creative London is a project to help young Londoners progress within the film and TV, video gaming, drama and other creative sectors.

Join London's Creative Industry

This short programme aims to enable old and young who are NEET / economically inactive to gain industry relevant and pre-apprenticeship skills and progress into sustainable employment or an apprenticeship in the creative sector.

Alongside training in specific job skills, participants are supported with:

- Overcoming barriers to work such as confidence, lack of recent experience, basic skills, jobseeking skills.
- Having a mentor who will guide them through the programme and further on until a sustained job or apprenticeship outcome is reached.

Within 4 weeks of completing the programme, we aim for participants to move into job roles or an apprenticeship, connected to the creative sector.
