| 16th April | Primary National Offer Day (NOD) |
| September | Confirm pupil figures with schools in 1 st /2 nd week back |
| October | Cabinet meeting |
| October - November | 8 weeks consultation begins (statutory is 6 weeks) |
| December | Review consultation responses |
| | Select Committee presented with recommendations – includes responses from consultations |
| February | Cabinet report submitted for approval following any recommendations or comments raised at the Select Committee |
| February | 28 th February - Deadline to determine admissions arrangements |
| March | 15th March - Deadline to publish determined admissions arrangements |
