We work in partnership with families and professionals to identify the family's/C/YP priorities and concerns and provide holistic emotional and practical support accordingly.


We work towards empowering families, not creating dependency, helping them to navigate the world of SEND.





Apps for learning British Sign Language:

Lingvano – This is an app similar to the popular language app Duolingo, that takes you through various signs and tests you on your understanding in a well sequenced series of learning modules.

Sign BSL – This is available for Android and Apple devices and for free online at www.signbsl.com.

BSL Hands (One and Two) – This is a project by Deaf Active North West which aims to teach 60,000 primary school children the basics of sign language.



ELSA UPDATES

The <u>ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistants)</u> training Cohort 4, spring 2023, is completed. Once you have completed the training, on-going supervision by the EP Service is required to maintain ELSA accreditation.

We will not be offering ELSA training this academic year (2023-2024) but will continue to offer half termly supervision for those who have completed the training. We will be developing a new project that runs in a similar vein and will focus on effective use of teaching assistants in schools.

Schools' ELSAs will take part in a survey to explore impact ELSA Training/ Supervision have had on their professional development, working with CYP and members of staff.

PLACEMENTS

We understand there are some pupils who may require a specialist placement attending your setting – and due to the national shortage, one is not available. We consult a range of settings, in and out of borough, independent and maintained but we need to ensure whatever placement is sought is an efficient use of resource. Please continue to advise families to contact SENDIAS for impartial support.

CONSULTATIONS

Please ensure you are completing consultations and returning within the 15 days. A gentle reminder these are shared with parents, and you must consider all reasonable adjustments and support to make a placement successful rather than a refusal.
