Main aims of the work

To ensure that there is a fair, transparent and effective funding system that supports:

- the right provision / support being in place at the right time as locally as possible linked to evidenced needs;
- identifying and sharing best practice and enabling it to become common practice;
- improved parent / carer confidence in Hillingdon's local provision.
- Efficient and effective use of funding/resources.



Intended Outcomes

Supporting and informing:

- a shared understanding of the range and levels of needs across Hillingdon schools and how that compares with other areas.
- a transparent and equitable system of resource allocation across
 Hillingdon with clear co-produced matrices of need, provision and then
 matching this to funding.
- identification of potential changes to the current system.
- improvement in the quality and clarity of EHCPs.
- evidencing the impact of resourcing on children and young people's outcomes.



Phase 1 – Desktop Review

- Mapping current activity
- Benchmarking across other LAs where information is available
- Analysing data and information
- Reviewing other models
- Proposing recommendations to take forward into Phase 2
- Constructive feedback and advice on work being undertaken
- It has informed the actions needed to carry out Phase 2 which will include involvement from a broader group of people representing the Council, schools and other partners.
