- To secure sufficient suitable education and training provision for all YP in their area who are over compulsory school age but under 19 or aged 19 to 25 with an EHCP or who have been in the care system.
- Have a strategic overview of the provision available in their area and to identify and resolve gaps in provision.
- Make available to all YP aged 13-19 and to those between 20 and 25 with SEND, support that will encourage, enable or assist them to participate in education or training Robust Tracking of NEET YP
