Prevention – Statistical school-based data

- 91 young people currently considered at risk of NEET across 3 schools only.
- 15-20 young people who are currently Hillingdon LAC across all schools in the 14-16 age group.
- 202 young people with SEND in Hillingdon currently in year 11 with an EHCP.
- 98 of the 202 are in mainstream school.
- 2091 young people between the age of 14-16 are considered 'deprivation pupil premium'
- Young people with SEND and care experienced are 7 times more likely to become NEET

- Impact data may shape the way in which vulnerable groups are supported

RONI protocol

- At risk of NEET dashboard led by the LA, created by the DfE
- Collating data from schools in the summer of year 10, January of year 11
- Plan is for LA's and schools to work closely to support young people who are at risk of NEET

Preparing for Adulthood partnership

- A whole SEND approach
- 12 schools signed up; primary, secondary, FE
- A self-evaluation of preparing for adulthood to encourage SEND learners independence
- Training provided, year 2 to shadow another school and role model what has been learned

Post 16 prospectus 2024

- Colleges like BCA and Capel Manor will feature to help young people who are interested in agricultural.
- Skills Builder and 2 x careers activities for parents/schools to use.
- Videos on internships/traineeships/T-Levels and apprenticeships

What strands have we bid for?

- Universal NEET Universal not in employment, education or training (NEET) programme: support young Londoners who are NEET to help them to develop interpersonal skills that increase their employability; and to progress into education, employment or further training outcomes.
- Targeted NEET Targeted not in employment, education, or training
 (NEET) programme: support young Londoners who are NEET, furthest from
 the labour market and experiencing multiple forms of disadvantage and/or
 who have significant additional support needs. This intervention will help
 them to develop interpersonal skills that increase their employability; and to
 progress into education, employment or further training outcomes.
- Quality work experience for students at risk of NEET programme: commission quality work experience provision for young people who are at risk of becoming NEET (not in employment, education or training) and who are aged 16-19, or aged 16-25 for students at risk of NEET and who also have an education, health and care plan (ECHP)
