Take-Up over 90%

Schools that are claiming additional funding for take-up over 90% are asked to provide a snapshot of data on school meals uptake at two points in 2024, via a form which is in the online guidance here: <u>Claiming additional funding for meals uptake above 90 per cent |</u> London City Hall

Independent Evaluation Schools Survey

ICF Research are running a survey for schools to capture how they are experiencing implementation of the expansion of the Universal Free School Meal scheme, what their barriers are, and if there are any challenges scaling up. All schools in London were sent a letter through the post in mid-January.

To ensure that we receive the most comprehensive picture of the London school food context, we would really value as many responses as possible. **Respondents will be entered into a prize draw for one of five £100 Decathlon vouchers.**
