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

- Total recoded so far...1042
- Compared to this time last year ...1433
 27% decrease :-)

EXCLSUIONS:

- Total recorded so far ...30 actual (-9 retracted)
- This time last year ...29 actual (-11 retracted)
 On par



What we've already done

- « Increase team capacity with the introduction of an officer.
- « Improved relationship between school and LA.
- « Greater collaboration with internal and external services to support children who have been permanently excluded.
- « Increase in the number of times schools have sought support from the Exclusion and Reintegration Team.
- « Increase in the number of retractions for permanent exclusions.
- « Improved process for data collection

- « Inclusion Clinics implemented
