## Entry Routes & Eligibility Criteria

### Police Constable Entry Programme (PCEP)

- 17+ – 57yrs
- Must have a level 2 in English at a GCSE grade C or above / 4-9 or an English language equivalent overseas qualification
- Must have 2 A-Levels or equivalent or
- Must have a level 3 qualification or be working towards one
- Starting salary of £36,775 pa

### Police Constable Degree Apprenticeship Programme (PCDA)

- 17+ – 57yrs
- Must have English GCSE A-C / 4-9 in English or equivalent
- Must have 2 A-Levels or equivalent
- On offer - 3 years fully funded BSc Degree in Policing Practice
- Starting salary of £36,775 pa

### Degree Holder Entry Programme (DHEP) PC/DC

- 18 – 57yrs
- Must have a GCSE A-C / 4-9 in English or equivalent
- Must hold a Level 6 Degree
- On offer - 2 years fully funded Level 7 Diploma in Policing Practice
- Starting salary of £36,775 pa

## Entry Routes & Eligibility Criteria

### Police Community Support Officer (PCSO)

- You must be 17 or older when applying to be a PCSO
- Must have English GCSE Grade C (or equivalent) *For those who do not hold this qualification, a written test will be available.*
- Starting salary is £33,348
- Working 36hrs
- Free travel on or off duty on London's buses



### Police Staff Roles

- Staff roles including admin, finance, HR, forensics, IT, data analysis, Met CC and many more
- Suitability will depend largely on the particular role in which you're interested
- Different pay scales and benefits for different roles
- Training is covered



### Special Constable (Volunteer Police Officers)

- Volunteer Police Officers
- Need to complete 200 hours Annually which is only 16 hours a month (2 x 8 hour shifts)
- Free TFL Travel
- Same power, uniform and responsibilities as a regular officer



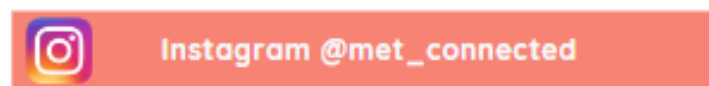
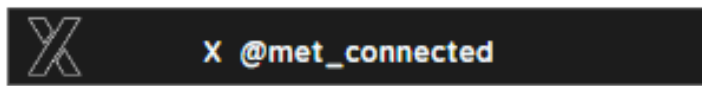
### Community Based Volunteers

- Must be over 18 and not be a serving police officer or existing member of police staff
- Reasonable expenses are paid for travel in London, to and from deployments.
- On offer a range of training opportunities including crime prevention training, personal safety and London life savers.
