
Cath will introduce the life of real puffins, tell the children about the island and the characters and outline the stories including a reading from one of the books.

There are resources to use ahead of the session:


Call the Puffins by Cath Howe activity sheets - The Reading Agency

Cath will be using the drawing activity on the day and will introduce a competition to draw and decorate your own puffin.








Wednesday 5 June 10.45 – 11.30am KS2
