Consent Workshops



Years 5 – 6th Form

1 Hour Long. Maximum group size is roughly 40 students.
In depth and discussion/activity led workshops going into consent and the students' issues.

Content is adapted to each age group but generally covers:

- The meaning of consent, and enthusiastic consent.
- How to ensure consent is present and how to assert boundaries.
- Older groups go into the issues of sexual violence in society.
- Younger group sessions focus on boundaries and consent rather than sexual activity.



Consent Assemblies



Years 5 – 6th Form

20 mins to 1 Hour. No max group size.

Interactive and engaging assembly on consent and sexual violence.

Content is adapted to each age group but generally covers:

- The importance of consent and the problem of sexual violence in society.
- The meaning of consent and what makes consent invalid.
- How we can approach relationships/sexual activity to ensure they are positive and healthy.



Active Bystander Workshops



Years 7 – 6th Form

1 Hour Long. Maximum group size is roughly 40 students. Engaging workshops that aim to empower students to challenge harmful behaviours and attitudes that lead to sexual violence like misogyny.

Workshops will cover

- How certain attitudes and beliefs lead to sexual violence.
- Why it is important to challenge them.
- How we can challenge those in an appropriate/safe way.


