Post 16 Transition document

- A one stop shop document that provides guidance on procedures/timelines.
- *Do you have the deadline for the tracking data?*
- *Most of our Year 11s haven't any idea until they get their exams results.*
- Strategies for certain characterised needs – SEND/LAC/YJS/Attendance.
- Contacts at HRUC along with alternative offers of provision – i.e. Princes Trust Programmes – which can help aid transition discussions.
- The role of the NEET team along with other providers.
- A Risk of NEET indicator form along with other templates that can be used.
- Young person's voice – what are their experiences of education especially around preparing them for adulthood.
