## Welcome to the AXIS monthly bulletin. Please see below trends and themes

- Axis has observed and been notified of 105 children coming to attention for risk of CCE (Child Criminal Exploitation) since the start of June 2024. This is around a 40% reduction since this same time period of last year.
- Following a noted dip in information sharing for CSE (Child Sexual Exploitation) since the start of the year, Axis have been encouraging professionals to be aware of the signs and indicators of CSE and share with Axis. Due to the influx of intelligence received Axis has identified a theme which has been shared with the police and is being actively investigated. An adult has been posing as a child and contacting children through Snapchat offering vapes and money for inappropriate contact.
- Please be mindful of the below apps (Snapchat, Telegram, Instagram, Facebook messenger, TikTok, Vevo) and share with Axis any CSE concerns you have.



- Axis is aware that adult drug dealers are posing as food delivery drivers to conceal and deal drugs within the Hayes Town area.
