## **Eligibility Criteria for Early Years Pupil Premium**

## Does my child qualify?

Your child may qualify for Early Years Pupil Premium if they are aged three or four years old, is receiving free early education hours at a nursery, pre-school or childminding setting and **any** of the following situations applies to you.

You are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Job Seeker's Allowance (Income-based)
- Employment and Support Allowance (Income-related)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of the State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit based on an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Tax Credit

## or your child has:

- been looked after by Hillingdon Council for at least one day
- been adopted from care
- left care through special guardianship or
- been subject to a child arrangement order
