

## FfT update for subscribing schools May 2020

### FFT 2020 GCSE Statistical Moderation service

The service went live on **Thursday 23 April** with the first wave of schools receiving their Subject Moderation reports on **Monday 11 May** as planned. We're currently on our 4<sup>th</sup> weekly upload window (which closes at 4pm today) with **our 5<sup>th</sup> and final window due to end on Monday 1 June**.

The uptake has been fantastic with **over 1,800 secondary schools uploading over 2.5 million teacher assessed grades** so far. The feedback has also been really encouraging (you'll find a few snippets in the email below) and it's been great to help out schools at such a difficult time. ### FFT's new interactive webinars

Whilst the KS4 moderation service has been running, the training team has also been busy hosting a range of interactive webinars. The sessions have been very popular with over **1,000 schools** joining our 30 min workshops. ### 2020 FFT Primary Results Service

In April, we outlined our intention to run a full 2020 results service for both primary and secondary schools. **We are now planning to open the Primary service on 3 June**. We have emailed all Aspire primary admin users to provide further details - [FFT 2020 Primary Results Service email sent to schools \(21 May 2020\)](#).

In summary:

- The service will operate across EYFS, KS1 and KS2

- The system will go live on **3 June 2020** and close on **3 July 2020**.
- Schools will be able to upload their Teacher Assessments in Aspire via the Aspire Pupil Tracking system or by using a pre-populated Excel template.
- Schools will be able to access their first early pdf KS2 reports by mid-July with full interactive Aspire KS1/2 dashboards (including Attainment and Value Added progress) available in August.
- A special EYFS pdf report will also be made available in August
- KS1 and KS2 estimate reports will be available in September

We'll also be running a new set of interactive webinars for primary schools. The short 30-40 min webinars will provide schools with an overview of the service and allow them to ask any practical questions about the process. LAs are welcome to come along as well. ## 2020 FFT Secondary Results Service

We'll be running a **full 2020 KS4 and KS5 results service for secondary schools**. The service will **start in August** once schools receive their final teacher assessed grades from exam boards, with full interactive attainment and value added reports **available in Aspire by September**.
