Dear Jo Palmer

This should be easy to rectify Jo.

In FMS if you go to Tools | Accounts Payable Parameters and then click on the Cheque Layout / BACS Parameters Tab.

Under the 'CHEQUE ELEMENT POSITIONS' you will need to click on the Element and ensure that Payee Name is visible and you will see the measurements (in inches or centimetres) below.

If you measure your pre-printed cheque to get the correct position both from top margin and from left margin and then alter the figures accordingly. On the right hand side, there is a diagram with help on where to measure to on each of the elements. It may be an idea to write down the measurements that are there now and then re-do the figures.

Once you've changed the dimensions for the Payee Name, you should be able to do a 'Test Print' on a plain piece of paper and then hold it up against the cheque to see if it's in the correct position.

Hope the above works - if not, please let me know.
