

The ASK Programme offers a wide range of free support for your school.

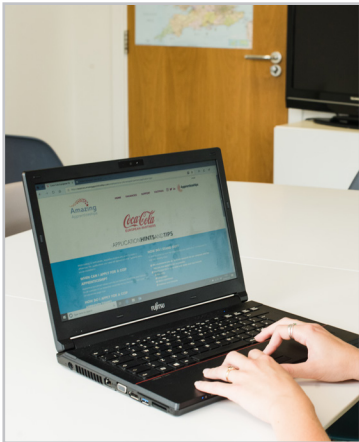
Face to face & online virtual activities

The face to face activities and online virtual activities are apprenticeship information sessions that are delivered by local experts (ASK Delivery Partners), on behalf of the Department for Education.

These are designed to inform and inspire your students, staff and parents about apprenticeships and other vocational pathways.



On the whole, they cover similar content, but are designed flexibly in light of the pandemic so that they can be delivered virtually or face to face, as and when each is appropriate.

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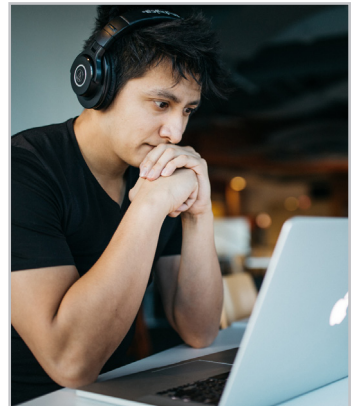
Interactive virtual workshops (Yrs. 10–13)

*Opportunity Area establishments are entitled to access up to 6 ASK activities, although if you feel that additional support is needed, please discuss this with your ASK delivery partner.

These areas have been selected based on a number of indicators, including deprivation, worklessness and lower levels of employment. There is likely to be less activity that exposes students to the opportunities within the local labour market, therefore this programme will support employability and apprenticeship awareness.
