- Brilliant Parents (BP) is a Social Enterprise which specialises in the delivery of Triple P, (Positive Parenting Programme) an internationally world renowned evidence based programme for a range of councils and organisations.
- BP has been supporting Hillingdon parents since 2017.
- Since 2021, we also provide a mentoring and befriending service to families whose children are at risk of exploitation in Hillingdon, staffed by Parent Champion volunteers.

Increase in youth violence across London

- Research has shown that since 2014 there has been a substantial increase in youth violence across London. Parents are concerned about their children, but do not feel they have sufficient support, help or knowledge to tackle the risks facing them.
- Our referrals reflect many of the children in question have experienced some kind of adverse childhood experience, which can contribute to them having difficulty with:
- ➤ Managing emotions
- ➤ Drug or alcohol consumption
- ➤ Staying away from home
- ➤ Not attending school
- ➤ School exclusion
- > Mental health issues
- ➤ Dis-engaging from family life

The Volunteer Parent Champion Model

- BP currently work with 15 volunteers
- Ethnicities include Albanian, Caribbean and Somalian
- Occupations include NHS nurse, Triple P Practitioner, Children's information and Advice Officer and HAYA project coordinator and home makers.
- 11 of our Volunteers are from Hillingdon. The remaining four are from surrounding boroughs
- Age ranges from 22 to 54 years.
- Service user referrals come from the following council departments;

 - Local schools

Benefits to Families

- Easier to relate to peers from the same community, rather than officials
- Increase level of trust in the advice given and sign-posting

- More likelihood to attend official meetings with peers
- Increased confidence in parenting skills and communication with their teenager and other family members
- Improve self care for parents
- Improve relationships with children
