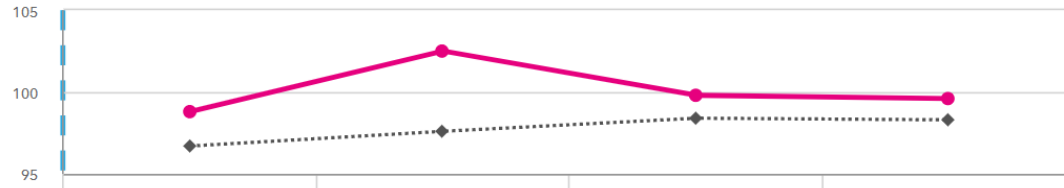

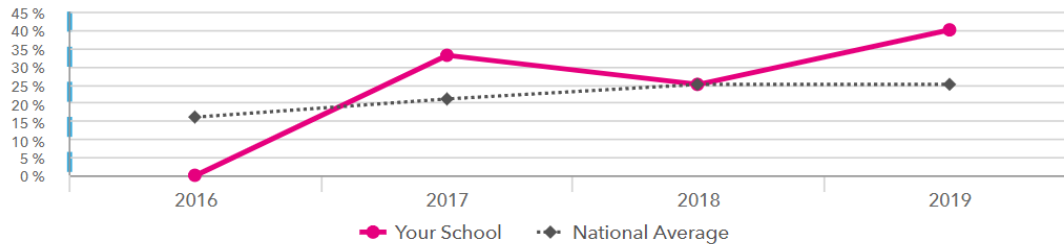

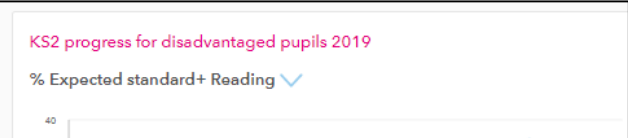

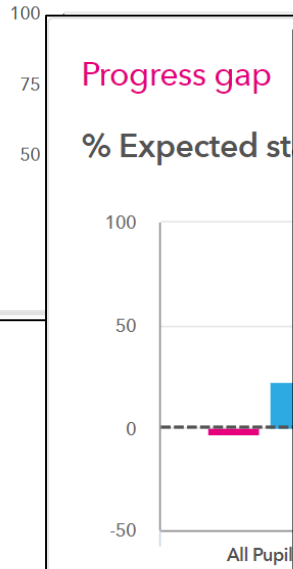

- FFT produced a set of interim reports in the summer
- In the autumn term; FFT produced the school's Self Evaluation Report of their data against the 'FFT *national*'

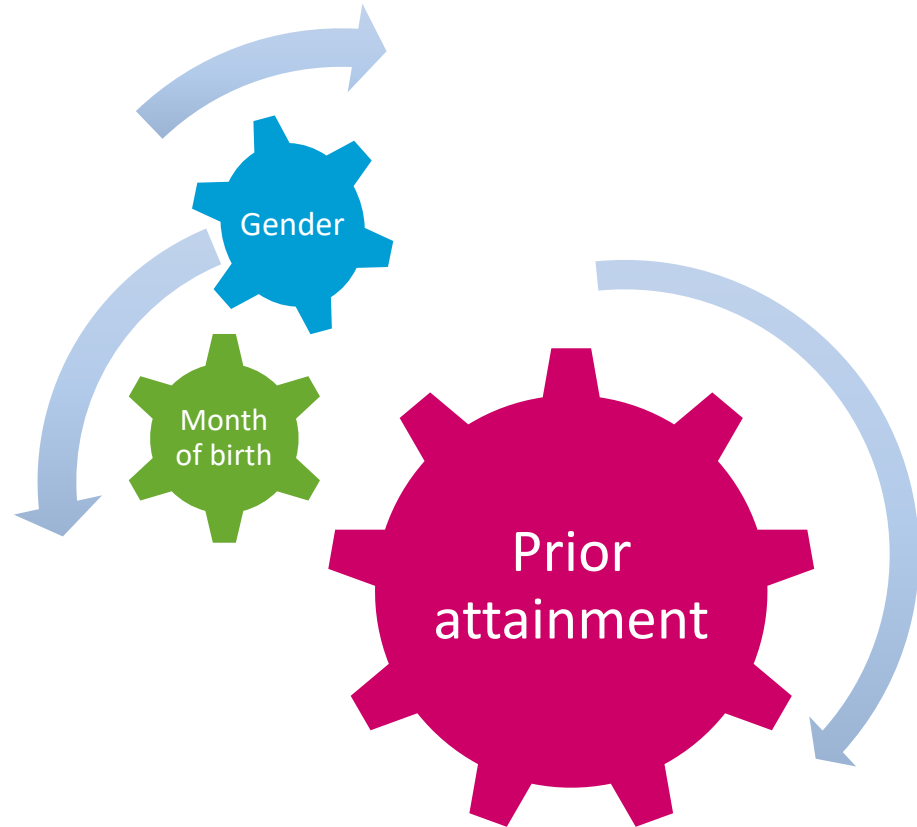

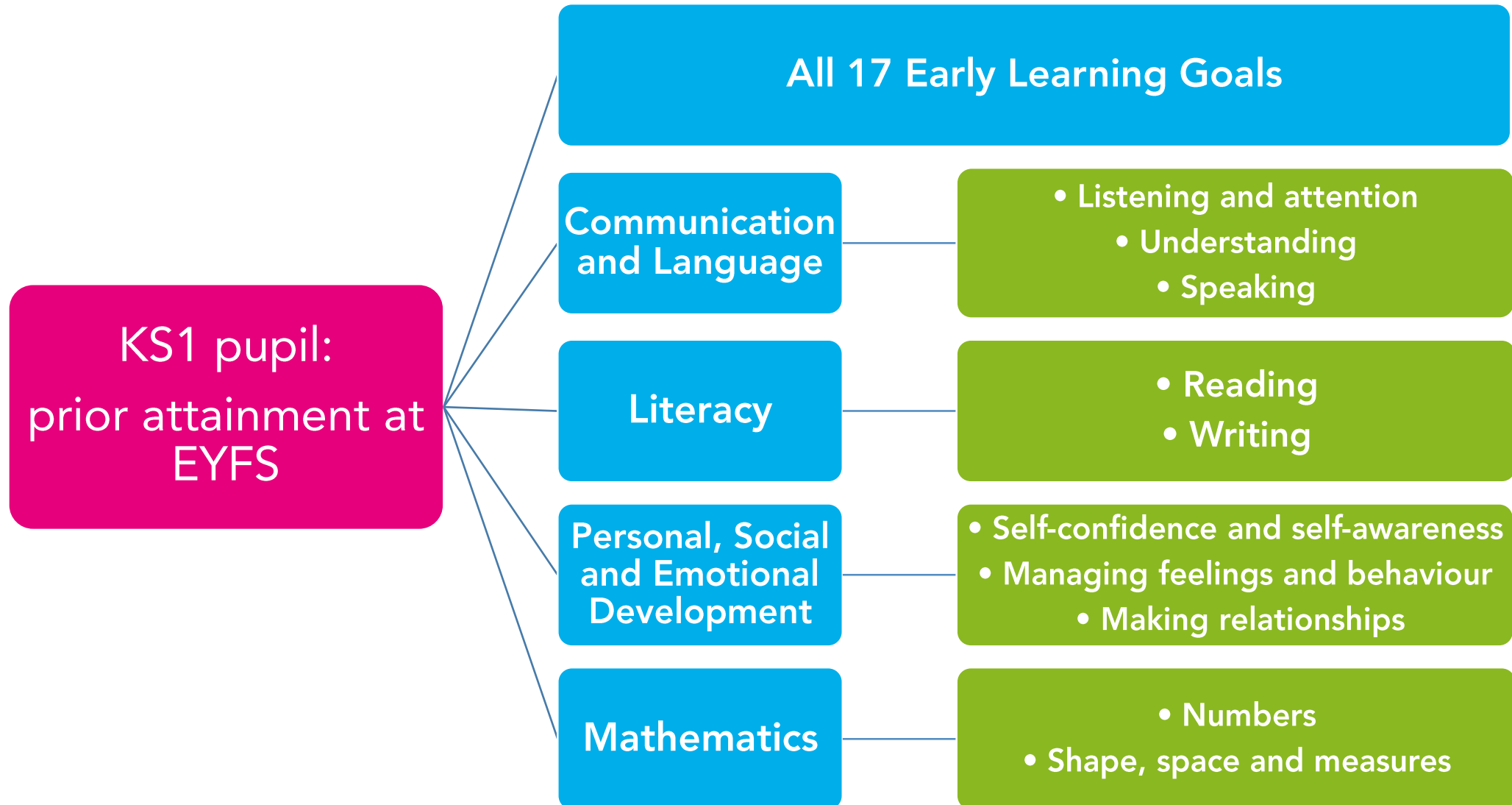

- Modelled on different levels of challenge to take account of school ambitions.



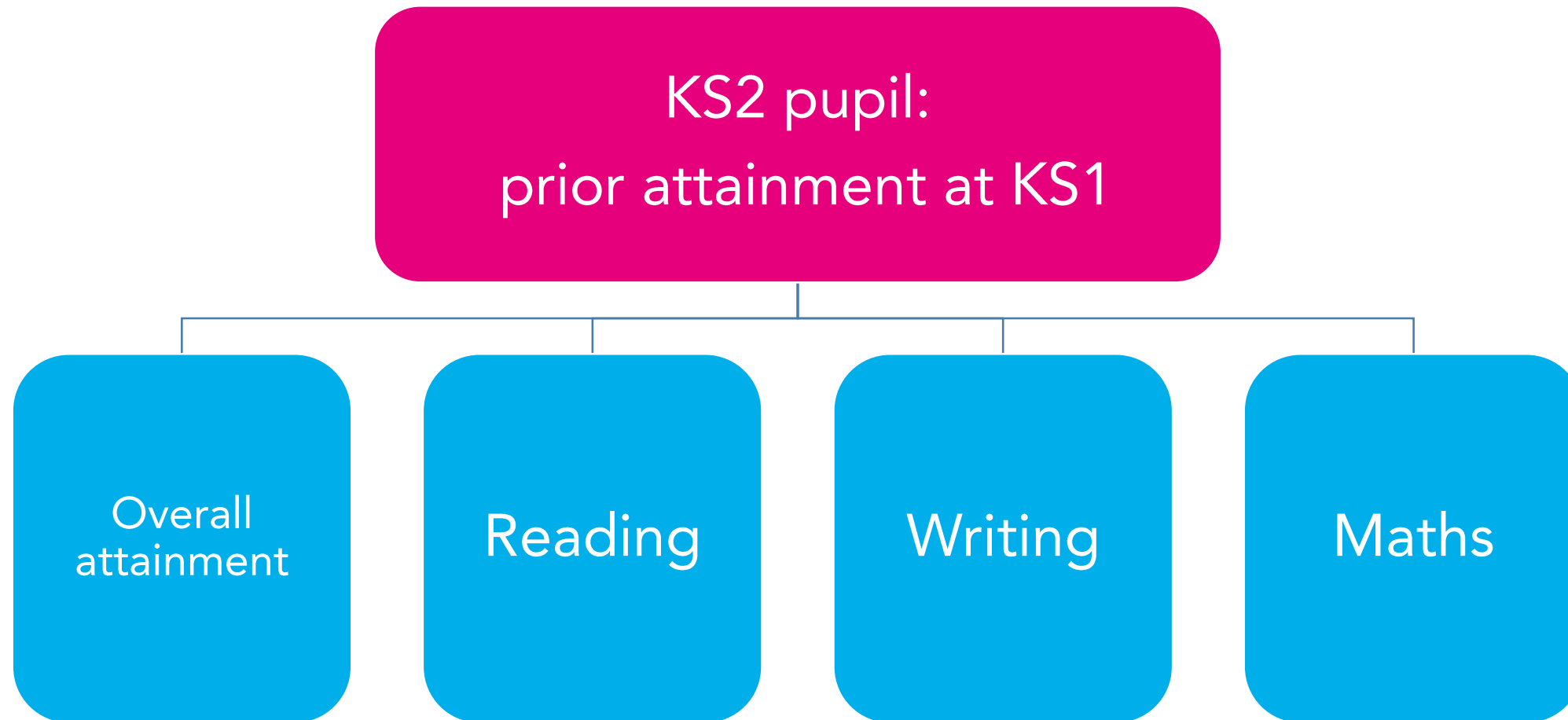

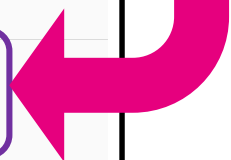

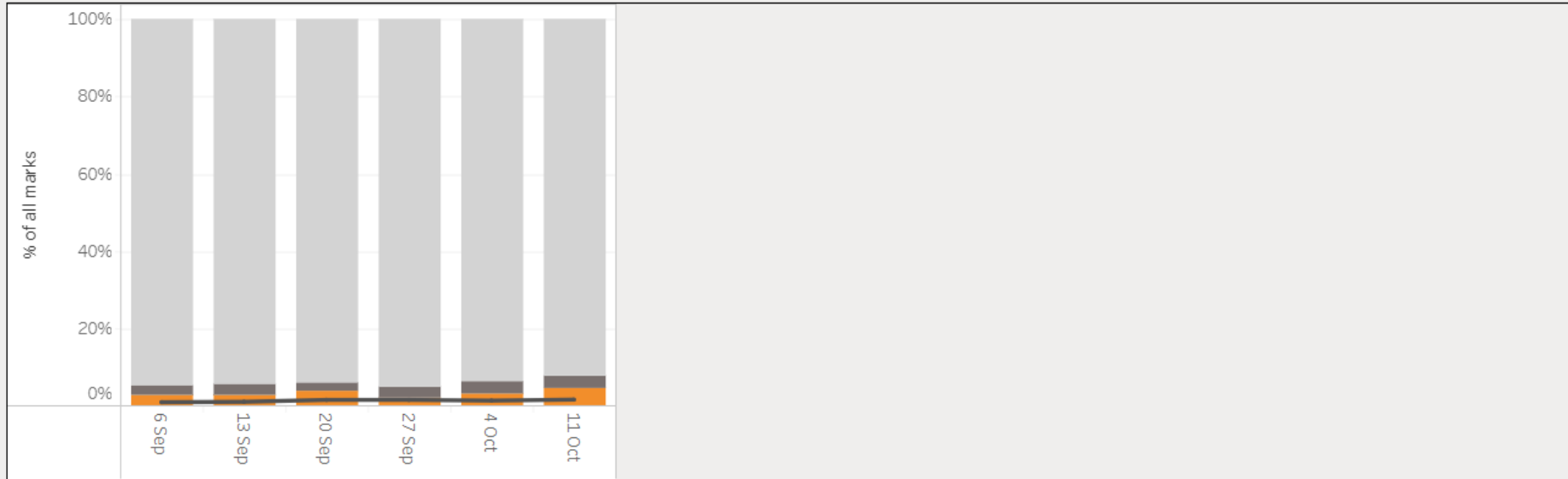

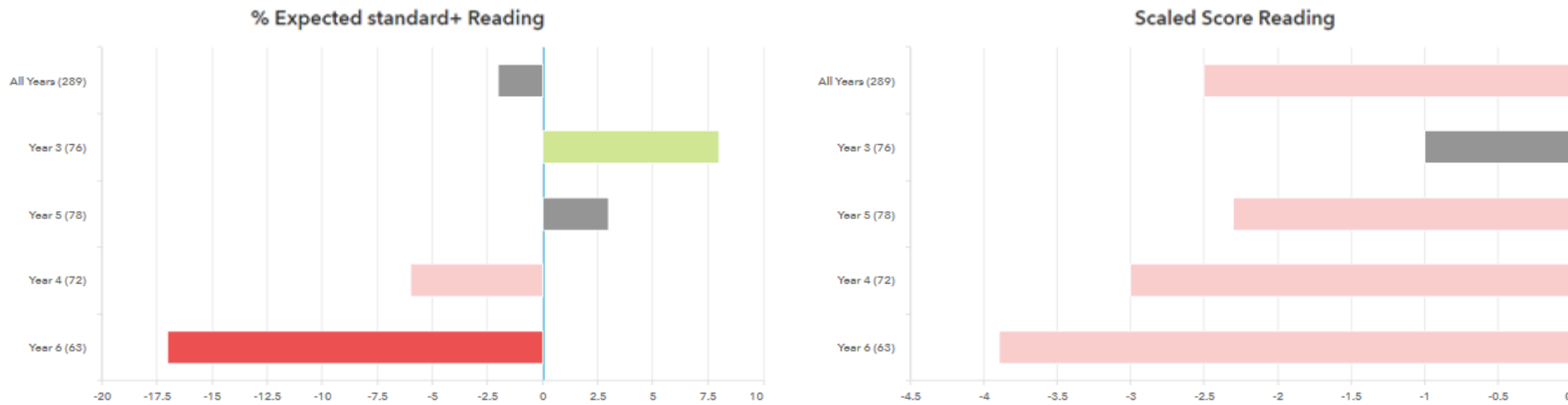

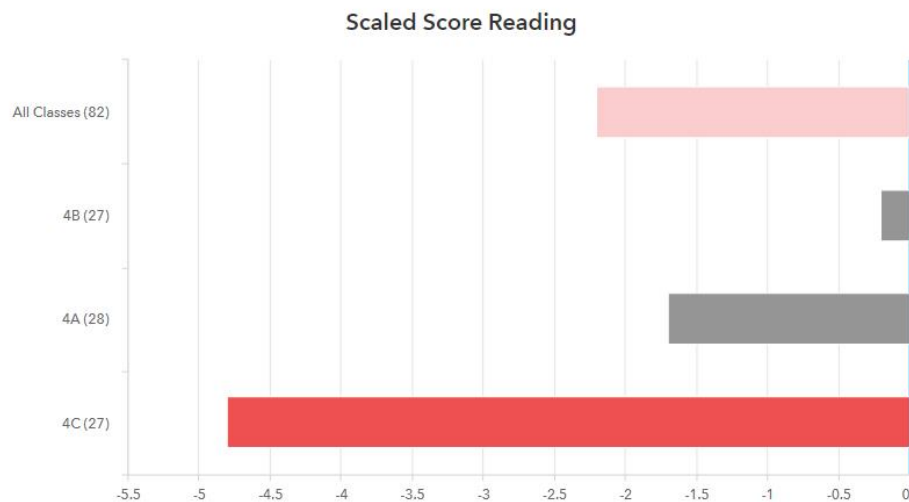
